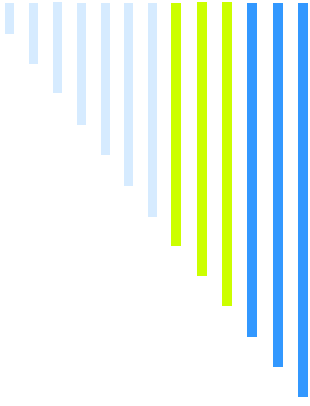

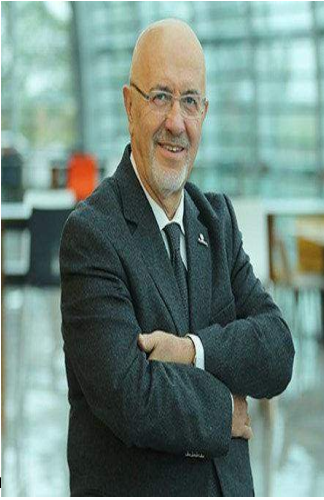

Dear students,

Welcome to our faculty, which started medical education at Okan University Tuzla Campus in 2014-2015 academic year. In this place where all kinds of medical equipment and infrastructure are fully fulfilled, our students will receive basic science education for three years.

In this training, the whole body of the human body will be taught in a system where the courses of Anatomy, Histology, Physiology, Medical Biochemistry, Medical Biology and Genetics, Medical Microbiology are integrated in a process extending from the

cell to the organs. In addition, they develop their clinical skills on models that are available in our modern simulation center. In this way, they gain experience about the procedures to be performed on the patient. Following this training, our students will begin their internship in our 250-bed hospital, where they will have one-to-one contact with the patient and receive their clinical information starting from the 4th semester. These internships will consist of various departments, in particular internal medicine, surgery, gynecology and obstetrics and child health and diseases. In term 6, our

students will join the physician army in our country as the graduates of Okan University Faculty of Medicine by completing the 12-month period in which communication and health problems are solved with the patient.

Dear Students,

Okan University Faculty of Medicine was established in 2013 and admitted its first students in 2014 in the first Medicine and Health Sciences Education Complex of Turkey in Tuzla campus. In 2020, its first students graduated. We offer programs in English and Turkish. The curriculum consists of 3 phases: pre-clinical internship, clinical internship and internship, in which basic and clinical sciences are integrated.

The first phase includes the first three terms. Our students, who take their first steps in medicine at Istanbul Okan University Faculty of Medicine, receive Basic Sciences education in modern lecture halls and laboratories in the Health Sciences Complex.

Our experienced lecturers will teach the human body in a wide range scale from cells to organs in a system where Anatomy, Histology, Physiology, Medical Biochemistry, Medical Biology and Genetics, Medical Microbiology courses are offered in an integrated system. Our medical faculty students also obtain clinical skills training in models at our modern simulation center and will gain experience before going to the hospital.

The second phase includes term 4 and 5. Students will have one-on-one contact with the patients in our modern Tuzla hospital with a capacity of 250 beds, thereby improving their clinical knowledge and skills.

The third phase is the 6th term or internship term. Physician candidates will practice medicine in the hospital and primary care under the supervision of clinical instructors and will exercise the knowledge and skills they have obtained until this year, and will ensure communication with the patient and solutions to health problems. Students who complete the 12-month period will join the physicians in Turkey as talented and competent graduates of Okan University Faculty of Medicine.

Goal of our faculty with a strong academic staff and infrastructure is to train students who love medicine as health professionals and as universal physicians who comprehend the importance of knowledge and academic thinking, who are curious, who are open to learning, who can apply and transfer what they have learned, who carry ethical values, who are pioneering, humane, who are able to work in teams, who are sensitive to the society and the world they live in.

In 2016, Okan University Hospital started to serve with the vision of contributing to the establishment of health standards of the future and to be among the leading organizations in the health sector.

The hospital is established on a closed area of 50.000 m², more than 500 employees, more than 100 faculty members and doctors, 250 beds capacity, intensive care unit serves as a fully equipped hospital.



EDUCATION IN OUR FACULTY

Integrated Training:

In the theoretical education of our faculty, based on holistic medicine approach, subjects are presented system-based with the contribution of related departments. Horizontal integration enables effective cooperation and communication between different disciplines, while vertical integration links basic and clinical sciences.



Practical training:

In the practical training of our faculty, the subjects which are theoretically based on the holistic medicine approach are explained in the laboratory environment with the contribution of the related departments. After the practical lectures and experiments in the laboratories, students are allowed to do the application themselves.





Education with Simulation

Despite the developments in the medical world, many people die because of medical errors. Experimental learning or simulation systems can significantly reduce medical errors. Simulation training; simple three-dimensional organ models, plastic models, realistic, advanced technology interactive patient simulators (robots), simulated / standardized patient,

screen-based simulators (laparoscopic training box), realistic, high-precision procedure simulators (laparoscopy, endoscopy) can be given. In our faculty, there is an advanced simulation center where such trainings can be given and models are used to improve the clinical skills of our students.

Clinical Internship and Intern Training



During the internship period, our students will reinforce the theoretical concepts given in the previous semesters with the practical training they will take in our research and practice hospitals. They will actively develop the knowledge and skills necessary for patient and disease management such as physical

examination, examination and treatment in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases accompanied by faculty members. Clinical internships are conducted at Istanbul Okan University Training and Research Hospital (Tuzla E-5-icmeler bridge). Internship, which is an important step in the transition to

medicine, has been planned in accordance with the education and training understanding of the University. In addition to compulsory internships such as Internal Medicine, Pediatrics and Family Medicine, our students are allowed to do elective internships for their areas of interest.



As the Department of Basic Medicine, our main goal is to prepare our students for the clinic and therefore the clinical

sciences as well as possible. For this purpose, our departments provide the most up-to-date information to our students and support them through practices. In our department, which aims to train researcher or academician candidates who can compete with their peers in developed countries and even pass them easily, our students receive adequate and necessary trainings on clinical practices

and ethical values and become ready for the clinic. Another goal of our department is to enable our students to understand lifelong learning, and to help make it a philosophy of life. Our department, aiming to do better every year, will be proud of the national and international success of our students in the future.

NON-MEDICAL COURSES:

HAPPY LIFE COURSES consist of courses organized by the Dean of Students of Okan University in order to develop themselves in terms of sport, art and socio-cultural aspects as well as the professional knowledge of our students.

Dean of Students Application Principles: Students must have registered and completed at

least 2 Happy Life courses by the end of 3rd grade. Students can attend the same course in two courses or choose different courses. Students can register for the courses through the OIS system in accordance with the day and hour schedule. Each Happy Life course has a pre-determined quota. Instead of the courses with full quota, other courses are available.

Assessment: 80% attendance is essential for Happy Life

classes. Students who fulfill this condition and get at least 50 points out of 100 will be considered successful in this course. Students who fail the Happy Life courses can choose any of the Happy Life courses at different periods.

Provisions regarding absenteeism are stated in the undergraduate regulations of our university.

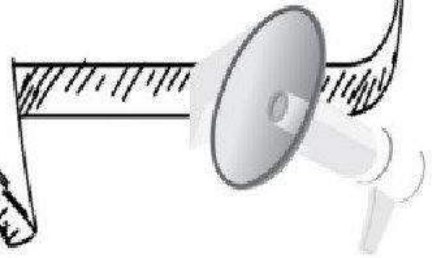

Attendance to classes

ARTICLE 19 - (1) The students of the Faculty of Medicine are obliged to take all courses of the academic year in which they are registered. Attending laboratory, discussion, seminars, clinical studies, field training and similar practical and theoretical courses is mandatory.

(2) The obligation to attend theoretical courses in the first, second and third semesters is applied as follows:

a) Students who fail to attend more than 30% of the theoretical courses in each of the first, second and third semester course boards without excuse are not taken to the examination of that course board and receive zero points (VF).

EXCUSES

ARTICLE 20 - (1) In order for students of the Faculty of Medicine to be considered as excuses during the education period, their excuses must be documented and this excuse must be accepted by the Faculty Administrative Board.

Form and application of exams

ARTICLE 22 - (1) In the form and application of the exams administered in the Faculty, the following issues should be observed:

- a) Examinations can be conducted theoretically (written, oral or both written and oral) and practical (written, oral or both written and oral).
- c) Practical exams are held before the theoretical exams in the course boards. Those who do not take practical exams cannot take the theoretical examination of that course board.
- d) Faculty members and instructors may take quizzes during the practice with or without prior notice. These exams can be added to the practical exam grade at the rate determined by the faculty members and instructors provided that they are documented. This rate cannot exceed 50% of the practical exam score.
- e) Students are required to take the exam at the date and time announced for the course committee, internship, final exam and make-up exams. Students who do not take the exam in time receive zero points from the course board exams, and "FF" from the final exams, make-up and internship exams.

Committee exams and evaluation

ARTICLE 23 - In the first, second and third semesters, exams are held at the end of each course committee. The committee exam covers all courses taught in that course board. The examination grade of a course committee consists of the sum of the scores obtained from the theoretical and practical exams. The score of the practical exams on the committee is determined not to exceed 25% of the total score of that course. The theoretical exam grade of a course committee is the sum of the scores obtained from all courses included in the exam. However, if a grade of less than 50% is taken from each of the courses covered by the theoretical examination of that committee, the barrage is applied. The barrage application does not apply to the committee practical exams.

Barrage application is done as follows:

- a) If the number of correct answers in any of the courses covered by the course committee theoretical exam is less than 50%, the difference in points below 50% is reduced from the total score of that course.
- b) The number of theoretical questions (points) less than 7 courses are combined to form a barrage.

Final, make-up exams and evaluation

ARTICLE 24 - (1) In the first, second and third semesters, at the end of each semester, the final exam covering the courses in all course boards is held. The grade obtained from this exam is processed as final exam grade. As a result of the evaluation of the final exams and course boards exams, students with a grade below 60 and a final exam grade of FF are given the right to make-up exams.

(2) In the final and make-up exams, the application specified in Article 23 of this Regulation is applied.

(3) The final exam shall be held no later than fifteen days after the last board exam date, and the make-up exam shall be held no later than fifteen days after the final exam date.

TERM GRADE

ARTICLE 29 - (1) The principles regarding the term grade are as follows;

a) Grade is calculated by adding 60% of the average of the grades taken from the course board exams in the first, second and third semesters and 40% of the final or make-up exams. In order to be successful, the term grade must be at least 60 points out of 100 and the final or make-up grade

b) Students who get at least 60 points in each course board exam and whose average score of course board exam is 75 and above are exempted from the final exam if they wish. The final grade of these students is considered as the average of the grades of the course committee. Despite the right of exemption, the grade of the student who takes the final exam is valid and is taken into consideration.

(4) For the non-committee courses, the midterm and final exams are graded and written on the transcript as "Successful" or "Unsuccessful". Success in these courses is a prerequisite for graduation from the Faculty of Medicine.

(5) Examinations conducted in all semesters in the Faculty of Medicine are evaluated over 100 full marks. The score, letter value, coefficients and verbal values used in the evaluation of the exams are as follows:

a) Examination grades:

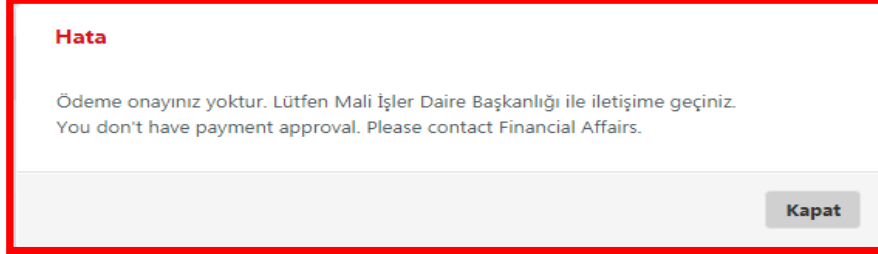

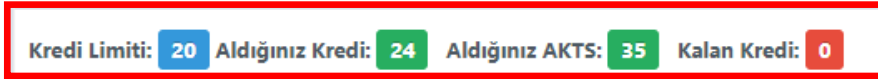
Course selections will be made from 04/09.2019 on <https://ois.okan.edu.tr/>. You have to make your course selections through the system on the relevant dates. If you receive the following warning when you log in to the system, you should contact the Financial Affairs Department.

Rules to be considered in course selection

You can take up to 2 credits per semester.



When choosing a course, you must first select the courses that you have already taken (FF / VF) or that you have never taken.

You cannot take courses if there is a conflict between the courses you registered for the first time and your VF. However, you can select the courses you have taken with FF before and even if there is a conflict. When conflicting courses are notified by the decision of the Faculty Administrative Board, no action will be taken.

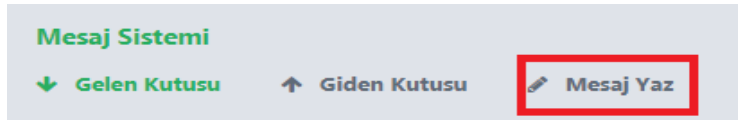
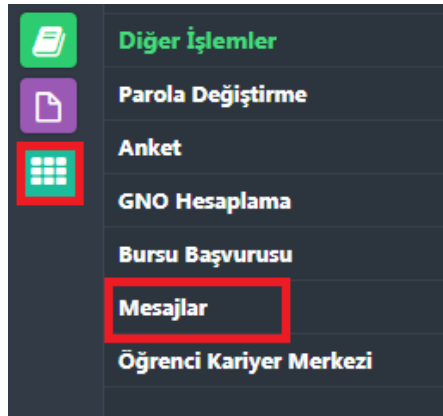
In the prerequisite courses, you must successfully complete the prerequisite course.

After completing your course selection through the system, you must submit it to the advisor for approval. You can see whether your course selection is approved / disapproved by your advisor on your course selection screen.

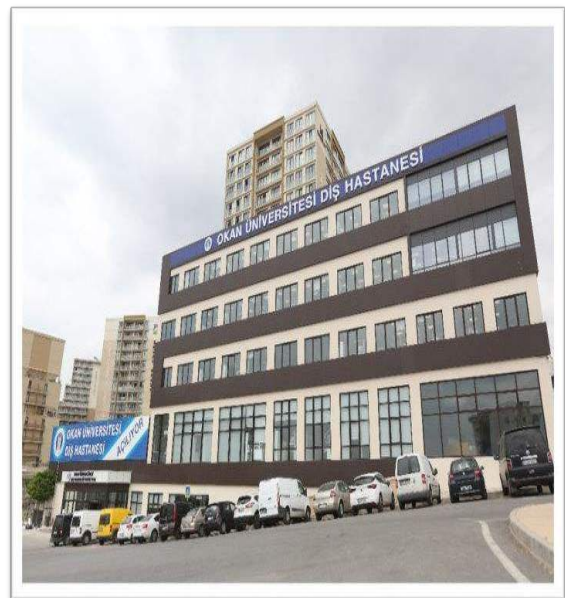
LIFE CENTER

Sports Complex (Indoor Gym, Indoor Swimming Pool, Pilates and Aerobic Studios, Sauna), as well as the facilities of a doctor and nurse constantly providing health services, food and beverage alternatives, stationery and grocery store also includes facilities. **Istanbul Okan University Psychological Counseling and Education Center (OPDEM)** is a unit that provides psychological counseling and guidance services to the students of Okan University (undergraduate, graduate, vocational high school).



OKAN UNIVERSITY DENTAL HOSPITAL

Our hospital, which was opened to service in Mecidiyeköy campus in 2014, has the latest technology equipments in 2500 m2 closed area. It serves in 8 different branches (Oral, Dental and Maxillofacial Radiology, Endodontics, Orthodontics, Pedodontics, Periodontology, Prosthetic Dentistry, Restorative Dentistry). In October 2017, our second dental hospital was opened in Tuzla Evora. Tuzla Dental Hospital, which has been established on a closed area of 8 thousand m2, has 108 dental units, 5 of which are diagnostic, Class A operating rooms, 3D tomography, dental laser unit, sterilization units, observation and observation rooms, laboratories, meeting and training halls.
